2. Every candidate shall opt Computer Science as compulsory subject. Examination and Evaluation of this subject shall be done at Board level and result in the form of Grades as well as Marks will be reflected on the Certificate.
3. Examination and Evaluation of Environmental Education will be done at school level and the marks obtained by the students will be sent to Board by schools.
4. A candidate who has passed the Matriculation Examination from a Board other than the Punjab School Education Board can opt Punjab History and Culture in lieu of the compulsory General Punjabi subject. Such students furnish proof of not having studied Punjabi at the Matriculation level.
5. A candidate who has passed Matriculation Examination from Punjab School Education Board with 'Punjab History and Culture' as a subject can opt for 'Punjab History and Culture' in lieu of compulsory Punjabi in the $12^{\text {lh }}$ class.
