STRUCTURE OF QUESTION PAPER

Note:

- All sections are compulsory.
- The Question Paper will comprise of 5 sections A,B,C,D and E.
- The Paper setter must follow the instructions of each section while framing the questions.
- All units of the syllabus must be given adequate representation in the Question Paper.

SECTION-A

Multiple Choice Type Questions: Questions No.1 will have 10 MCQ type sub-questions of 1 mark each. It shall cover whole of the syllabus. **10×1=10**

SECTION-B

Objective Type Questions: Questions No.1 will have 10 objective type sub-questions of 1 mark each with one word to a sentence answer type. It shall cover whole of the syllabus. **10×1=10**

SECTION-C

Question No.3 comprises two sub-parts I and II, one will be source-based and one will be case study-based. It should be relevant to the syllabus. **12×1=12**

Source based Questions (SOB): Sub-part I will be a comprehension paragraph which is from the syllabus but **not directly** from text book necessarily. 6 questions of 1 marks each will be asked based on the paragraph. **6 marks**

Case Study based Questions: Sub-part II will be a comprehension paragraph of any case study describing a citizen's experience with Political Science. 6 questions of 1 marks each will be asked based on the paragraph. **6 marks**

SECTION-D

Short Answer Type Questions (SA): This section comprises of 6 questions carrying 4 marks each. There will be open choice given with the total of 9 questions out of which any 6 have to be attempted. Answer to each question should be in about 60 to 75 words. This section shall cover whole of the syllabus. **06×4=24**

SECTION-E

Long Answer Type Questions (LA): This section comprises of 3 questions of 8 marks each with 100% internal choice given. Answer to each question should be in about 125 to 150 words. This section shall cover whole of the syllabus.
