**STRUCTURE OF QUESTION PAPER**

**Note**

- 1. The question paper will comprise of 5 sections i.e. A, B, C, D and E.**
- 2. All questions are compulsory.**

**SECTION-A**

**Multiple Choice Questions: Question No. 1** comprises of 10 sub questions (I to X) carrying 1 mark each. **10×1=10**

**SECTION- B**

**Question No.2** comprises of 10 sub questions (I to X) carrying 1 marks each.  
Answer to each question should be in one word or sentence. **10×1=10**

**SECTION-C**

**Question No.3** comprises two sub-parts I and II, one will be source-based and one will be case study-based. It should be relevant to the syllabus.

**Source based Questions (SOB):** Sub-part I will be a comprehension paragraph which is from the syllabus . 6 questions of 1 marks each will be asked based on the paragraph.

**Case Study based Questions:** Sub-part II will be a comprehension paragraph of any case study. 6 questions of 1 marks each will be asked based on the paragraph. **6×2=12**

### SECTION-D

**Question No.4** comprises of 9 sub questions 1 to 9 out of which 6 question have to be attempted. Each question carries 4 marks. Answer to each question should be in 50-60 words.

$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

### SECTION-E

**Question No.5** comprises of 6 sub questions with 1 to 6 out of which 4 question have to be attempted. Each question carries 6 marks. Answer to each question should be in 125-150 words.

$$4 \times 6 = 24$$
