**STRUCTURE OF QUESTION PAPER (THEORY)**

1. The question paper will cover whole of the syllabus.
2. There are 3 sections in the question paper i.e. Section A, Section B, and Section C. Section A is compulsory for all the students and students may choose only one section from Section B and Section C. Section A, Section B and Section C will be set from the Part-I and Part-II and Part-III of the syllabus respectively.
3. Total 9 Questions will be set in the question paper.
4. All units of the syllabus should be given adequate representation in the question paper.
5. There is no word, line or page limit for numerical questions.
6. The use of non-programmable simple calculator is allowed.

**SECTION-A**

**Multiple Choice Question:** Question No. 1 consists of 16 sub parts (i to xvi) carrying 1 mark each including **multiple choice / fill in the blanks (with two options) / True-False / one word or one sentence type** questions. (Answer to these questions should be given in 1 to 15 words).

**16x1=16**

**Very Short Answer Question:** Question No. 2 consists of 7 sub parts (i to vii) carrying 2 marks each. (Out of which 3 will be the theoretical and 4 will be numerical) Answer to each question should be in 40-60 words.

**7x2=14**

**Short answer type Question:** Question No. 3 consists of 3 sub parts (i to iii) (with internal choice, out of which 2 will be the theoretical and 4 will be numerical). Each question will carry 4 marks. Answer to each question should be in about 80-100 words.

**3x4=12**

**Source Based / Case Based Question:** Question No. 4 comprises of 2 **Source Based / Case Study Based questions** (i to ii) with 6 follow up questions. Each question carries 1 mark. Students are required to answer the questions based on these paragraphs.

**2x6=12**

**Long answer type Question:** Question No. 5 (with both numerical in internal choice) will carry 6 marks. Answer to this question should be in about 120-150 words.

**1x6=6**

## SECTION-B and C

**Multiple Choice Question:** Question No. 6 consists of 4 sub parts (i to iv) carrying 1 mark each including **multiple choice / fill in the blanks (with two options) / True-False / one word or one sentence type** questions. (Answer to these questions should be given in 1 to 15 words).

**4x1=4**

**Very Short Answer Question:** Question No. 7 consists of 3 sub parts (i to iii) carrying 2 marks each. (Out of which 1 will be the theoretical and 2 will be numerical) Answer to each question should be in 40-60 words.

**3x2=6**

**Short answer type Question:** Question No. 8 (with both numerical in internal choice) will carry 4 marks. Answer to this question should be in about 80-100 words.

**1x4=4**

**Long answer type Question:** Question No. 9 (numerical with theoretical in internal choice) will carry 6 marks. Answer to this question should be in about 120-150 words.
